



## European Championships – Belfast 2002

### ECC 50 Overs Duckworth Lewis Playing Conditions - Amendments for the 2002 European Championships:

The Tournament Regulations being used at this Tournament are the ECC 50 overs with DL modifications as found on this website.

The following are **ADDITIONS** to the Regulations as printed and will be followed for this Tournament:

**4.1(b)** Reference to Tournament Referee is to be interpreted as the umpires/3<sup>rd</sup> umpire at the ground.

### **13.The Result**

#### **ADD - 10 Over matches**

Provided both sides have the opportunity of batting for the ten overs, the team scoring the higher number of runs shall be the winner.

In the event of a tie, the following shall apply: The team losing the fewer number of wickets shall be the winner. If the result cannot be decided in this way, the winner shall be the team with the higher score (irrespective of wicket lost) after 9 overs, or if still equal after 8 overs , etc. If the scores are equal at every over then the match is tied.

#### **13.2 Scoring of points**

ADD - Tie = 1point

#### **13.1(e) AMEND TO:**

In the event of it not being possible to achieve a result with the above, 5 nominated members of each team shall, under the supervision of the umpires, bowl one overarm delivery at an unguarded wicket, conforming to Law 8 and pitched at a distance of 22yds. The sides will bowl alternatively, and the side which bowls down the wicket the most number of times shall be the winner.

If the 'scores' are equal at the end of this 10 ball bowl out then the remaining team members will bowl a ball alternately at the wicket to achieve a result on a 'sudden death' basis.

#### **RAIN DAYS**

These have been set aside to cater for bad weather. If a rain day is available then matches will be a minimum of 25 overs per side and NOT be reduced to 10 overs nor to bowl outs.

e.g. if Friday's game is rain affected it will be played on Sunday i.e. not reduced to 10 overs or a bowl out.

If the rain day has already been allocated to a match (eg above) then if a subsequent match is rain affected, since no rain day is available, then it could be reduced to a 10 overs match or a bowl out.
