ICA Match REGULATIONS Junior matches 2011/2012

CBC HARD BALL LEAGUE
REGULATIONS

1, VENUE
All games will be played on the Beer Sheva Cricket Ground
2, AGE LIMIT
Players must be between the ages of $12-15$
3, GAME FORMAT
The game will be played with a hard ball between 2 teams of 11 players.
The game will be limited to 2 innings of 15 overs.
4, BOWLERS
A bowler may bowl a maximum of 3 overs.
5, RESULT
The game has ended when the team batting second has passed the score of the team batting first OR when the 15 overs
of the second innings have been bowled. The team with the most runs is the winner. Where scores are even at the end
of a match, the result will be a draw, regardless of the amount of wickets fallen.
6, POINTS
Win....... 10 points
Draw....... 4 points
Loss........ 0 points
7, BONUS POINTS
Bowling Points.......9,10 wkts...... 3 points
6,7,8 wkts......... 2 points
3,4,5 wkts......... 1 point
Batting Points
Team batting $2^{\text {nd }}$ looses but makes $90 \%$ of winning score.... 3 points

## 8, WIDES/NO BALLS

From over 1 to 12 of each innings wides and no balls will bring a penalty of 2 runs. In the last 3 overs of each innings, wides and noballs will bring a penalty on 1 run plus an extra ball.

9, PLAYERS SHORT
If, for any reason, a team is short of players, the captain has the right to use up to 2 players from the team not playing that day. However, the Tournament Organiser will not allow a "borrowed" player to be of a higher standard than the player he is replacing.

10, The ICA 2010 Playing Conditions and Code of Conduct shall apply to all CBC matches unless amended in the above regulations.

## AFIK GIRLS LEAGUE and NORTH GIRLS LEAGUE

## REGULATIONS

1, The tournament will consist of 6 teams. The 6 teams will be divided into 2 groups of 3 , who will play eachother on a round-robin format. The top 2 teams in each group will play eachother in the Final.

2, Each team will consist of 10 players
3, For the batting side, each batter will receive 6 balls, and for the fielding side, each player will bowl 6 balls.
4, The batting side will receive 2 points for each wide or no-ball, and no extra ball will be bowled.

5, A batter hitting the ball onto the side fence will be awarded 2 bonus points, and onto the back fence(behind the bowler) 4 bonus points.

6, After each over, fielders will rotate their positions in a clockwise manner.
7, 4 points will be awarded for a win, 2 points for a draw, and 0 points for a loss

## AFIK BOYS LEAGUE and NORTH SCHOOLS LEAGUE

Each student must play at least 1 game.
Each team must wear same colour shirts.
Each class will choose a captain.
MATCH RULES
Each team will bat for 20 minutes.
A ball hit into the side fence -- 2 bonus points, the back fence --4 bonus points, over the fence --6 points and OUT.
Each dismissal -- minus 3 points.
A batsman will retire on his individual score of 20.
The full 20 mins of the innings must be played out and both retired and dismissed batsmen may bat twice.
At least 4 players in each team must bowl.
wides/no balls -- 2 runs
POINTS
Win -- 4 points
Draw -- 2 points
Loss -- 0 points
In the case of all 3 teams finishing with 1 win, the team having scored the most runs throughout the tournament will be the winner.

## NEGEV SCHOOLS PESSACH LEAGUE APRIL 2012

1, Participating teams: Ma'anit(BS), Afik(BS), Itzhak Sadeh(Dim), Kol Ya'akov(Yer), El Madge(Hura)
2, Matches will 2 innings of 15 overs, all of which shall be played out.
3 , A batter will retire having reached an individual score of 25 .
4, Each dismissal carries a penal;ty of 3 runs.
5 , Once all the batters have been dismissed, both retired and dismissed batters can bat a second time without run restrictions.

6 , Bonus points for boundries will be dependent on the ground, and the TO will decide on the day.
7, Bowlers will bowl a maximum of 3 overs. Not every player has to bowl. Underarm bowling will be allowed.
8 , First 12 overs - wide/no ball $=2$ runs. Last 3 overs $=1$ run+extra ball.
POONTS AND BONUS POINTS.
1, Win $=10$ points, Draw $=4$ points, Loss $=0$ points.

## NORTH BOYS U13 <br> LEAGUE

1. The league will consist of 7 teams
2. Each team will have a minimum of 8 players.
3. Each match will consist of 15 overs per innings.
4. Every member of the team will bowl a minimum of 1 over.
5. Every member of the team will get an opportunity to bat.
6. At the end of each over, the fielders will rotate in clockwise manner.
7. In the result of a wide delivery or a no ball - the batting team will be awarded 2 extra runs but the bowling team would not be required to bowl an extra ball.
8. A semi hard ball will be used in each match, players will not be required to wear any protective gear.
9. The playing area will be a large grass area or a hard ball court that is big enough to host a junior cricket match.
10. If there is a change of date of a fixture - organisers would need to be informed prior to the scheduled match

4 points will be awarded for a win
2 points will be awarded for a tie
0 points will be awarded for a loss

NEGEV PESSACH and SHARON PESSACH

Matches will be 2 innings of 15 overs, all of which must be bowled.

2, A batter will retire on reaching an individual score of 25 runs

3, Each dismissal carries a penalty of 3 runs.
4, Once all the batters have been dismissed or retired, all batters may return to bat a second time without a run restriction.

5, Bonus points for boundaries will be dependant on the ground, and the TO will decide on the day of the match.
6, Bowlers can bowl a maximum of 3 overs. Not every player has to bowl. Underarm bowling will be allowed.
7, First 12 overs - wide/noball $=2$ runs. Last 3 overs - wide/noball $=1$ run +1 extra ball.
8, Points

Bonus Points (for losers only)
50-70\% of winning score = 1 point
$70-90 \%$ of winning score $=2$ points
Above $90 \%$ of winning score $=3$ points

## 8) AYELET

GAMES

The tournament will be played on a Round-Robin basis, with a Final between the top 2 teams. Each match will consist of two 15 over innings, and all the 15 overs must be played out. This means that players may bat twice in 1 innings even though they have been dismissed.

A batsman will retire when he has reached an individual score of 30 .
Five runs will be deducted from the score for each dismissal.

In the first 12 overs, wides and no-balls will be penalized by 2 runs with no extra ball. In the last 3 overs, wides and no-balls will be penalized by 1 run with 1 extra ball.

Bonus runs for boundaries will be determined after ground inspection.
